

# North Wrestlers Win; Area Has Many Champs

North Farmington emerged with the Farmington district Class A wrestling championship Saturday, while Catholic Central secured as winner of the "A" meet at Redford Union and John Glenn just missed the crown in the meet at Romulus.

Out of the three districts also came a parade of observant champions, and runner-up who next move on to the regionals this Saturday.

The performers from North Farmington and Romulus qualify for the regionals at Ann Arbor Pioneer...the Redford Union winners and runner-up go to Hazel Park.

Ken Jones of Glen at 123, Charles Young of Glen at 130, Lyman McLilly of Glen at 145 and Garden City West's Rick Stewart at 155 and heavyweights Essa Sakliah emerged winners at Romulus.

Area champs at Redford Union were Thurston's John Wheeler at 95, Dennis Campbell of RU at 107 and Dave Kroll of Thurston at 130.

Jawor, one of the well-known family of golfing brothers from the Detroit area, leaves the San Marino course in Farmington to take the new assignment.

In recent years Jawor has been in charge of the Redford Golf Course, one of the Detroit municipal links; Bonnie Brook, San Marino, which he served as the first pro; Ann Arbor Country Club and then back to San Marino last year.

For the first time Braeburn will have a pro shop and remodeling of the basement for lockerroom and club storage has already started.

Jawor also plans to have golf carts available—another first for the course. He is spending most of his time at the course and will be ready to open for play as soon as the weather breaks.
