Farmington Township Trustees Rezone 3 Industrial Parcels

FARMINGTON
The Farmington Township Board Monday rezoned three properties and made two minor changes in zoning ordinances.

The three zoning changes were related. Three industrial sites were changed to residential classifications.

MOST DISCUSSION centered on a parcel on the west side of Farmington Rd. between Eight and Nine Mile.

Township Attorney Joseph T. Brennan said the township planning commission requested the change from light industry to residential "to forestall any push for additional industrial" along Farmington Rd.

Trustee Tom Nolan, also a member of the planning commission, said the area is not industrial property and not properly residential.

"If they were to come in with a logical request for office or something, then we'd consider it," Nolan said.

"What we don't want is further industrial," he added, "but where we go from that I don't know."

ALSO CHANGED were two lots near the intersection of Nine Mile and Tuck Rds. The land was also changed from light industrial to residential. Brennan said the lots are surrounded by business and residential property.

"At least our map would be consistent" if the change were made, Brennan said.

The third property rezoned is near 11 Mile and Orchard

Lake Rds. Brennan said it had been zoned industrial since the township's master zoning land calls for no industrial land in the area.

One of the changes in the zoning ordinances concerned front lawn requirements. It provides that 50% of the front area of an office zone must be in grass and landscaping. The remainder may be used for parking.

The other change requires that all marginal access roads conform to grades approved by the township board. Brennan said the change was
