## Jury rules Boucher is guilty in wife slaying

Former Birmingham orthodontist Dr. Daniel Jl. Boucher will appeal Mon-days first degree murder werdlet for the murder of his ex-wife to further ex-tend the longest running criminal case. in state history. from spearler trial on the marder charge. Boucher, now 56, was convicted Monday of the 1968 shotgam murder of Blanche Boucher in the West Bloom-field bothe they once shared. A jury of three women and nine men found him guilty of the slaying following 2<sup>th</sup> hours of deliberations. Jurors rejected the defense of tem-porary insaulty based on Boucher's be-lief that his former wife was ruining him financially. The court ordered sale of his 700-acre estate near Oxford for unpaid allmoov earlier on the day of
