#### WSU professor Thomas Rumble dies in Florida

Dr. Thomas C. Rumble, 82, former dean of Graduate Studies and professor of English at the university, died Chursday, April 2, in St. Petersburg, Fla., following a lengthy illness. The body was cremated.

Dr. Rumble, formerly of Farmington, retired July 1, 1979. He joined the facutty as an assistant professor of English in 1989 and was promoted to a full professorship in 1966. He served as dean of Graduate Studies from 1917.75, then returned to teaching duties in the English Department.

Prior to coming to WSU, Dr. Rumble served on the teaching staffs of Louisiana State University of Mississippi, and the University of Mississippi.

## Yeager elected GOP secretary

The battle was a jockeying for new coalitions, Yeager said, be-tween moderates and conservatives. Yeager was a Ronald Reagan sup-

porter in the November presidential election although he initially backed Gov. John Connally for the presiden-

Gov. Joan Connaily for the presiden-tial nomination.

Gov. William Milliken's people were Bush supporters, as was Yeager's challenger.

Engler, whose husband is state Rep. John Engler, was a Bush cam-paigner but had support from Reagan conservatives at the meet-ing.

Yeager's final support came from the Milliken wing, which had worked for a Bush candidacy. Yeager heads Yeager & Co., a workman's compensation insurance company in Southfield. He has been a township trustee since 1978.
