

WSU professor Thomas Rumble dies in Florida

Dr. Thomas C. Rumble, 62, former dean of Graduate Studies and professor of English at the university, died Thursday, April 2, in St. Petersburg, Fla., following a lengthy illness. The body was cremated.

Dr. Rumble, formerly of Farmington, retired July 1, 1979. He joined the faculty as an assistant professor of English in 1959 and was promoted to a full professorship in 1966. He served as dean of Graduate Studies from 1971-75, then returned to teaching duties in the English Department.

Prior to coming to WSU, Dr. Rumble served on the teaching staffs of Louisiana State University, Tulane University, the University of Mississippi, and the University of North Carolina. He held B.A., M.A. and Ph. D. degrees from Tulane University.

Yeager elected GOP secretary

West Bloomfield Township Trustee Weldon Yeager narrowly was re-elected as Republican State Committee secretary Saturday.

Yeager's eight-year hold on the job was challenged by former state Rep. Colleen House Engler of Mt. Pleasant.

After a first ballot 52-52 tie, Yeager won the second try, 54-51.

"Miliken's people backed me," said Yeager following the weekend state central committee gathering at the St. Joseph Holiday Inn.

The battle was a jockeying for new coalitions, Yeager said, between moderates and conservatives. Yeager was a Ronald Reagan sup-

porter in the November presidential election although he initially backed Gov. John Connally for the presidential nomination.

Gov. William Milliken's people were Bush supporters, as was Yeager's challenger.

Engler, whose husband is state Rep. John Engler, was a Bush campaigner but had support from Reagan conservatives at the meeting.

Yeager's final support came from the Miliken wing, which had worked for a Bush candidacy.

Yeager heads Yeager & Co., a workman's compensation insurance company in Southfield. He has been a township trustee since 1978.
