Hassles with the township arose because Suburban Softball Complex sits atop a landfill. That's why you'll notice a mobile wastewater system, mobile offices and mobile concession stands.

"No buildings were allowed on the site by the township," Dieters said. "There are 2 feet of clay beneath the grass, and trash under that. The ground is very conducive to our purposes."

No paving was allowed by the zoning board, either. The parking

lot, with a capacity for 300 cars, is gravel.

The quest for a liquor license presented another contest.

"We figured that by serving beer we'd have more control over people bringing in their own," Dieters said. "But we couldn't convince the Board of Trustees of that."

"They recommended we not get a license right away. I think we'll get it eventually, though."
