## Enjoy a 'muddy' sport

All kinds of unusual sports have been devised since cavemen first took to solving their conflicts with clubs.

Probably one of the most unusual of today's sports and certainly a Johnny-come-lately, is mud-bog racing.

It is an offshoot of tractor pulling. The purpose of the sport is to see how far an individual can drive a four-wheel drive jeep or car through a long, narrow mud bog. Whoever gets the farthest before getting stuck, wins.

The bog is produced by finding an area with the water table close to the surface and digging up the topsoil to get a thick, deep pile of mud.

VEHICLES BEGIN from either a stop position or get a short lead run into the bog. A long towing wire is

attached to the vehicle before it makes a run.

It's a good, thing, too, because the vehicles usually get stuck.

Martin Moorehead, who is affiliated with the Wolverine Four Wheel Drive Club, explained the attraction of mud-bog racing.

"Guys sitting in bars bragging how good their cars are can prove it," he said.

Moorehead added that mud-bog racing may be within the financial reach of more people than tractor pulling. It is especially popular in the south, Moorehead added.

The Wolverine Club, with members who reside all over Southeastern Michigan, will sponsor a race on April 26 at the Hell Creek Ranch in Hell, Mich.

Vehicles will be matched against

others with similar wheel widths. The three divisions are: under 10 inches, 11-14 inches and 14 inches and above.

It is still possible to sign up to compete in Hill later this month. Contact either Jim Rogers, 427-4218, or Ron Martenka, 278-7188, for particulars. An entry fee of \$10 will be assessed.

Spectators are also welcome. There is an admission charge.
