The win brought him a gift certificate from Art Alcove, another local

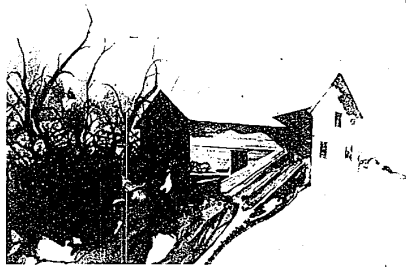
supporter of Farmington Artists Club.
