

"That doesn't mean newspapers should no longer consider it important to act as a watchdog," says Ms. Lehnert, but rather that promoting that aspect might not attract younger readers.

Exigant's chief adviser on the domestic economy wrote a book several years ago that proved there were no poor people in the United States. This was done by careful calculations with the "poverty line" which was determined by multiplying the minimum cost of food for a family of four for a month by a factor of three because food supposedly represents one-third of a family's monthly budget.

Hemingway was only partly right. The difference could also be political.
