

# Reagan cuts could hurt students, LIT official says

President Reagan's proposed budget cuts could mean a large reduction in the number of middle income students at Lawrence Institute of Technology in Southfield.

That's the word from Paul Kinder, director of financial aid at LIT who last week echoed the sentiments of other public and private college and university administrators around the country.

Although LIT is a private college, the changes under consideration in Congress could affect more than 800 students attending LIT under the Federally Insured Student Loan or Basic Educational Opportunity Grant programs, Kinder said. Currently, both types of financial aid are available to students from both lower and middle-income families.

"If the proposed cuts are made in the

two programs," Kinder said, "by far the hardest hit will be those students from middle income families."

"Those in the lower income brackets will still be able to qualify even if the needs analysis or maximum income re-

quirements, suggested by the Reagan administration, are put into effect by the Congress."

According to LIT, many middle income students who need financial aid current take advantage of the Federally Insured Student Loan program. The program makes no stipulations about family income levels. Any student can borrow up to \$2,500 a year from a local lending institution which the federal government picking up the 9 percent interest charge while the student is in college.

"RIGHT NOW, THOUGH," Kinder said, "there are three proposals being discussed for changing the system. One would raise the interest rate to 10 percent, leaving the basic program intact. The second would remove the government subsidy on the interest while the student is in school, causing some problems for the banks in collecting the money that they would most likely abandon their part in the program. The third proposal," Kinder said, "requiring needs analysis or maximum

income requirements in order to qualify, could mean a reduction of 25 to 75 percent of the number of students eligible for the loans, depending on the criteria passed by Congress.

"Those cut from the program," Kinder argued, "would be students whose families are earning \$25,000 a year, or more — the middle income bracket."

Within the last few weeks, the government has ordered a freeze on the processing of all applications for the Federally Insured Student Loan program. The LIT financial aid office and other colleges adopted a "wait and see" policy.

"It's really a very bad time for students because we don't know what will happen by next fall," Kinder said. "Cuts could mean that many students could stand a chance of having to drop out of college because the loan and grant programs were the only means available to them to continue their education."

"Now," Kinder said, "students will either have to wait and see what is available or find alternate funding, which is not very likely."

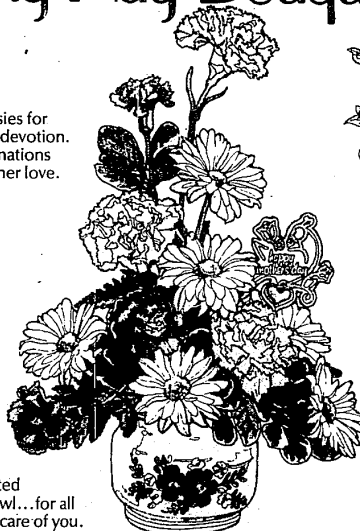
