Now is the time to give your lawn a good start. At the locations you're ashamed of, rake out dead growth with a steel rake and use a weed killer to stop the crab grass (an annual), which enjoys finding an open place on the lawn to establish its tentacles. Spray

Fertilize after you are satisfied with your policing of the condition of the lawn floor. It pays to buy good lawn seed as the cheaper grades are filled in with inferior seed. You will discover some "fine" perennial rye on the market which is competing with feetucky Bluegrass. Deep watering is necessary until it becomes established, unless Mother Nature covers the assignment. Purchase your seeds and plants from a reputable seed company or garden center. Remember, the cheaper buy int's necessarily the better buy. If you are planting polatoes, get them from a

are planting potatoes, get them from a seed store or a farmer's cooperative where you can get certified disease-free seed potatoes.

Be sure to buy tomato seeds or plants from a reputable dealer. These

plants should have been grown from seed previously treated for fusarium and verticillium disease. and verticillium disease.

The best way to start seeds inside and avoid damping off is to use a solless planting medium, available at garden centers. You can sterlize your own soil by placing it in a can and baking it in the oven for one and a half hours at 350 degrees.

As you plant your vegetables, re-member that squash, melons and toma-toes are susceptible to the same dis-eases. So, separate those plantings.

move suckers, a mix of 10-percent Chlorox will disinfect the knife. Rinse in clear water.

You can sterilize soil in a trash bag.
Add two and a half tablespoons of for-

malin (40 percent formaldebyse) to one cup of water and mix with a bushel of moist soil. Seal and dorty plant seeds until the soil has been "aircet" for two days as the odor is toxic to plants and bothers people.

There is a 4-foot shrub, Excéchorda (often called pearl bush) which in the spring has a mass of white flowers which look like pearls. Its growth is compact, and it would be a perfect selection for a courtyard. It has a long flowering cycle. I noticed it in the Wayside catalog.

As gardeners, let's get our ducats to-gether. At any age, gardening as a hob-by is tops. You get exercise, you get to enjoy the outdoors and gain a feeling of satisfaction. And a good garden (from trees to annuals, toss in the lawn, too) increases the value of your property.


