# Kermit Ambrose honored

## AMBROSE HONORED

The new all-weather track at Birmingham School has been named the Kermit Ambrose Track recognizing the area's longtime cross country and track coach.

A dedication ceremony honoring Ambrose took place on Tuesday before the Seaboard-Fernside boys' and girls' track meets. Ambrose was employed as a teacher and coach in the Birmingham School District from 1951 until his retirement in 1976.

As a coach at Seaboard, Ambrose had a combined track and cross country record of 189-23, including 55 championships. In his 16 years of coaching, Ambrose won 94 track meets and lost only six, including 11 Southeastern Michigan Association championships. His teams finished second in the league three times, won five regional titles and finished third at the state meet three times. In 13 years of coaching cross country, his record was 95-17, including 11

league championships, nine regional titles, nine Oakland County crowns, two state championships and two state runners-up finishes.

# Open house set for tennis center
