SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 19, 1981**

Farmington Hills City Council held a special meeting May 19, 1981. Mayor Wolf opened the meeting at 8:00 o'clock P.M. Members present were Burwell, Soronen, Wolf and Lange. Others present were City Manager Savage, Assistant City Manager Costick and City Attorney Bibeau.

Council introduced zoning map amendment C62-246 parcel 23-100-003 to rezone from RA-1 to RC-2.

Introduction was made for zoning map amendment Ordinance C62-247 to rezone part of 23-21-376-017 from L-1 to B-3.

Amendatory ordinance C62-248 was introduced to rezone lots 482 and 483 of Grand River Crest Subdivision from RA-2 to P-1.

Council introduced zoning map amendment C62-249, lots 4, 5 and 6 of Park Hill Subdivision from RA-2 to OS-2.

Zoning map amendment C62-250, was introduced to rezone lot 7 of Park Hill Subdivision from RA-2 to OS-2.

Zoning map amendment C62-251 was introduced to rezone lots 23-100-001 from RA-1 to IR-10.

Introduction was made for Amendatory Zoning Ordinance C62-KK to divide Article D.C. OS-1 and OS-1A, Office Districts into two separate Articles.

Council approved vacating of Valley Road and Old Colony Road lying adjacent and contiguous with lots 18 and 40, the north half being retained by the City and authorizing the developer to enter and landscape City property.

Special Assessment roll C155-Road Improvement for Franklin Knolls Subdivision was confirmed in the amount of \$202,719.

Special Assessment Roll C157 - Road Improvement for Franklin Fairway Sub. was confirmed in the amount of \$434,357.

Special Assessment Roll C156 - Halsted road improvement was confirmed in the amount of \$33,941.12.

OIA Hemstead Subdivision Road Improvement Special Assessment District C152 was confirmed in the amount of \$347,113.29.

Susan Rennels was appointed as a member of the Board of Canvassers.

Council approved to award the contract to Pacella and Forest Contractors Company in the amount of \$3,800 to construct flood control structure in connection with storm drain improvement at 10 Mile Road west of Industrial Park Drive and that the requirement of sealed bids be waived.

Upon motion meeting adjourned.
