Farmington Hills resident Dr. William Carpenter will be honored at a special banquet given by National Foundation for Ileitis and Colitis (NFIC) following its medical seminar for physicians this spring.

The surgeon is a founding member of the NFIC's Michigan Chapter Scientific Advisory Board who actively participates in open meetings to educate the public on the malady.

Ileitis is a disease characterized by inflammation of the small intestine.

Colitis is inflammation of part or all of the colon or large intestine.

About 100,000 new cases of ileitis and colitis are diagnosed each year. But because diagnosis often remains unrecognized for long periods, estimates are that there may be two million persons in the U.S. with ileitis or colitis of varying severity.

There is no medical cure known for the diseases, and the clinical course of each are both varied and unpredictable.

THE NFIC is a non-profit research-oriented organization dedicated to finding the cause and cure of the diseases.

The foundation is committed to a nationwide coordinated research program, which is supported solely by contributions from the public.

The dinner for Carpenter, set for June 3 in Dearborn's Fairlane Manor, will help raise funds for the continuing research and at the same time honor a member of the chapter's board.

"Dr. Carpenter's surgical career spans a 40-year period during which time he touched the lives of many patients with inflammatory bowel disease," said Sylvia Bartlett, speaking for the local chapter of NFIC.

"Because of his great kindness, he has helped many patients through surgical and medical crisis."
