

Beethoven work touches the heart

The music presented by the President's Trio of Oakland University at Friday's Nightcap with Mozart was as clear and crisp as the night itself.

In a performance aided by the presence of dimmed, romantic house lighting, violinist Misha Rachlevsky, violist Paul Silver and cellist David Saltzman combined their fine solo talents to create a strong, firm chamber trio sound that could be heard and appreciated for all of its parts as well as for total effect.

The major piece performed Friday was the demanding Trio in E flat by Beethoven presented in six movements. The piece is musically demanding. Musicians must maintain great flexibility during the performance and give constant attention to the rigorous demands of a Beethoven work at the same time. The trio was successful in achieving this difficult balance as the strength and deep romantic nature of the piece reached a high point in the fourth

movement or adagio section. Long, thoughtful musical lines were created with great care — the performance took the Beethoven work straight to the listener's heart.

The remaining works on the program were written in two open, but very different styles. The trio's fine treatment of a Hoffmeister work allowed the audience to hear what great breadth can be achieved through the wide use of the ranges of the instruments and an encore performance of a Grieg piece served as a forum for some fine solo work by each member of the trio in a round-like fashion.

Nightcap series host and founder Rachlevsky insists that the added effect of dimmed lighting will continue until the sound of snoring from the audience overpowers the music presented each Friday at 11:30 p.m. at Birmingham Unitarian Church.

The Aeolian Harp Trio will play tomorrow. Artists are Mary Scudder, flute, Kevin Plunkett, cello, and Patricia Terry, harp. For concert information call 951-8934.

The commencement address was delivered by the Rev. Paul Hartling, the United Nations high commissioner for refugees and former prime minister of Denmark.

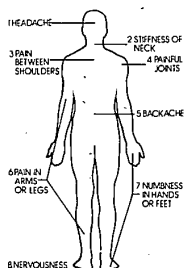
