mass hysteria swept the colonial village and sent scores of innocent people to jail. Nine individuals, who refused to "confess" to black-art dealings with the devil, were sent to the gallows.

Miller has said that every one of the 22 characters in the play, while changed somewhat to fit the dramatic necessities of the story, actually took a similar role in the grisly events that did occur in Salem.

Though Miller's story has been shaped to have an obvious relevance to the political investigations of the 1950s when it was first produced, "The Crucible" is still an accurate portrait of the terror

and ferocity with which a few Americans once accused each other of allegiance to the devil.

Everything was ready for the cruel frenzy that swept the town and came to a climax in the year covered by "The Crucible."

Thirty years before Salem, the Puritans had named four Quakers in Boston for heresy. At the time of the Salem trial, even educated men like Cotton Mather accepted "satanic molestations," as he called them, as facts of nature.
