Miller has said that every one of the 22 characters in the play, while changed somewhat to fit the dramatic necessities of the story, actually took a similar role in the grisly events that did occur in Salem.

Though Miller's story has been shaped to have an obvious-relevance to the political investigations of the 1950s when it was first produced, 'The Cruelber' is still an accurate portrait of the terror

and ferocity with which a few Americans once accused each other of allegiance to the devil.

Everything was ready for the cruel frenzy that swept the town and came to a climax in the year covered by "The Crucible."

Thirty years before Salem, the Puritans had hanged four Quakers in Boston for heresy. At the time of the Salem trial, even educated men like Cotton Mather accepted "satianic molestations," as he called them, as facts of nature.
