# Champ De Vicenzo ready to defend

Roberto De Vicenzo turned professional at age 15 and has been competing at full swing ever since.

- 58 - nor the miles Neither his age between Oakland Hills Country Club and his Argentina residence are about to deter De Vicenzo from attempting to defend his title July 9-12.

An international golf fixture for three decades, the Buenos Aires-born golfer added to his more than 200 trophies by besting the field at the inaugural U.S. Senior Open last year at Winged Foot in Mamaroneck, N.Y.

De Vicenzo captured the win with a 72hole score of 285 - four strokes ahead of his nearest challenger, amateur Bill Camp-

Among the feathers in De Vicenzo's golf cap are the 1967 British Open Championship (a two-stroke victory over Jack Nicklaus); the Bob Jones award - the United States Golf Association's highest honor for distinguished sportsmanship in golf --

and induction into the American Golf Hall of Fame in 1974 and into the PGA Hall of Fame in 1979.

De Vicenzo has won the Brazil Open, the . Belgian Open, the Chile Open, the Columbia Open — the list is almost as long as a roll call at a session of the United Nations' General Assembly.

It was the 1968 Masters tournament, however, that etched the Argentinian into many Americans' memories.

De Vicenzo had apparently completed 72 holes in a tie at 277 with Bob Goalby. But De Vicenzo had signed an incorrect scorecard, giving himself a four on the 17th hole instead of his actual three.

Goalby became the Masters' champion by one stroke.

De Vicenzo and his wife Delia have two sons, Roberto and Eduardo, and two grandsons as well.
