Hospital exhibits start second year

For the past year, a changing display of original art has been featured in Henry Ford Hospital's West Bloomfield Outpatient Center. The displays, done in cooperation with the Birmingham Bloomfield Art Association, have featured the work of a different artist each month.

The project made its debut in June 1980, with watercolors and collages by Linda Zalla of West Bloomfield Township. Others whose works were featured during the first year are Julie Dawson, Suzanne Velick, Janet Clarke, Sonia Molner, Robert Kuester, Marie Merideth, Tamara Essner, Frances Waring, Evelyn Wright, Joan Fromm and Rachael Resnick.

For one of the artists, Julie Dawson of Birmingham, the project holds special significance. As a result of her exhibit at the outpatient center, she was commissioned to do four paintings for the fireplace lounge at Maplegrove. This is the new alcoholism treatment center which shares the site with the outpatient clinic.

Mrs. Dawson's four paintings depict the stages of growth of a maple leaf, beginning with the red leaf of fall, followed by the curled and withered leaf about to fall. The next two paintings portray the blossoms and the green leaf in prime growth.

"I love to do things of nature — to make something little fill a whole painting so people can appreciate the detail. I hardly realized the maple had a blossom or how beautiful it is until I did these paintings," Mrs. Dawson said.

Maplegrove therapist Jim Settle gave his interpretation of the Dawson paintings: "When the alcoholic comes in for 28 days of treatment, the person is sort of like the dead leaf — defeated, ready to drop. The treatment process is

like being reborn. Sobriety leads to a new life when you're mature, like the green leaf, when you find the freedom to be yourself."

Art exhibits at the outpatient center will continue through the coming year with seven paintings on the theme of

summer flowers by Linda Wagenberg, Birmingham watercolorist.

Among those scheduled to follow are Peggy Flarr, Fran Levin, Carol Hadley, Lois Wood, Dorothy Albert and Frieda Rubin.

The paintings on display at the cen-

ter may be seen by the general public during regular business hours. They are usually available for sale and information on price and how to contact the artist is available. The center is on Maple, west of Drake, West Bloomfield.
