# Farmington squad stands 6-5

## Legion whips Auburn Heights

The Farmington American Legion baseball squad stretched its record to one game above .500 (6-5) with a 9-5 victory over Auburn Heights Legion in summer baseball action Wednesday.

Rich Nutter of North Farmington High threw the first 5 1/2 innings to gain the win. He allowed three hits and one run, walking two and striking out three.

Ron Raymond earned the save in relief. He struck out one, walked one, gave up four runs and four hits.

Nutter helped his own cause with a 2-for-3 performance, including a double, single and two RBIs. He also scored two runs.

Barry Williams was 2-for-3, scored three runs and collected two RBIs.

Mark Leonetti chipped in with two singles.

LAST WEEKEND began with a bang and ended with a whisper for Farmington.

After defeating Novi Friday and taking both ends of a Saturday double-header against Rochester, Farmington fell to Ferndale, 7-3 and 6-2, in a doubleheader on Sunday.

In Sunday's opener, Farmington racked up a dozen hits. Joe Hamilton had a perfect day at the plate, going 4-for-4 and collecting two RBIs.

In Saturday's action, Farmington fireman Paul Wenson notched a narrow 8-7 win over Rochester.
