## **Heorodt gains Hope post** Stone skipper takes 1st place

John Kolar of Birmingham killed two titles with one stone Sunday. And he virtually skipped to victo-ry doing so.

ry doing so. Kolar is the current world cham-plon in the sport of stone skip. He defended his 1977 world record of 24 skips at the Sunday's 8th annual Mackhane Island International Stone Skip Fournament. More than 1,800 persons watched the contest. Kolar's toss sent his stone for 17 skips — the best throw of the day.

stone for 17 skips - the best throw of the day. The University of Cincinnati in-dustrial-studies major shares the world record (entered in the Guiness Book of World Records under the sport's original mame, ducks and trakes) with Cilen Loy of Gond Blane and Troy's Warren Klope, who first fashioned the record-24 skips in 1975. The Little David trophy, a 75-pound rock, was awarded to Kolar. He also received a year's supply of fudge.
