abeletionest and printer of Sandwich, Canada, they formed a land holding company. Destitute black families allotted 25-acre homesteads on easy financial terms. The society purchased a large tract of land south of Windson, which was subdivided.

Lattra Eavilard started a school in the sectlement in 1852. A.L. Power of Farmington, Harvard Hallock and Nathan Some were members of the Nath of overseers of the Refugee

THE LIVONIA meeting was less

stable than the Farmington meeting. In 1843, members joined with New York Quakers, such as Susan B. Anthony, Lucretia Mott and Elizabeth Cady Stanton, in challenging provisions of the Book of Discipline, which outlined the role of ministers and elders.

The Genesee yearly meeting disowned or dropped from membership those Friends who would not abide by the Discipline. In 1848, dissident Quakers in Adrian, Livonia, Battle Creek
