● **YOUTH SOCCER** — Registration continues through August 14 at the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation office for children in grades kindergarten through fifth. Children are placed in three divisions within a zoned soccer concept. Games are played on Saturdays beginning Sept. 12. Fee is \$10 per participant.

The fee is \$25 per participant.

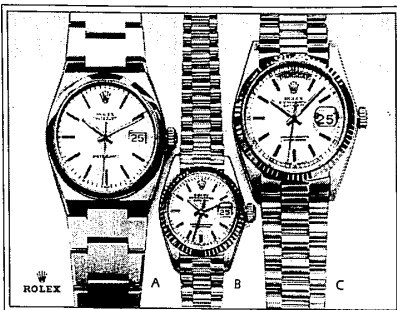
ALICE A. ROSSEN
