

An aggressive move that could either cinch the game or lose it would be for white to move a checker from the 8 and 5 point, closing the 4 point. This move duplicates the 6s black needs to litt and cover. Since white could easily cover that the survey could become an instant winner or lose.

The last visable option, which is neither too conservative or aggressive, is to bring a checker down from the 12 point to the 8, leaving a simple direct 1 shot. This move allows white to keep his prime intact, maintain the 5 point anchor, create one builder and still control the outer boards. I prefer this move since it accomplishes much andy leaves black one chance to hit, with 1-1 as the only disaster roll.
