

# WSU announces Southfield classes

Registration has begun for the fall semester graduate and undergraduate credit courses at Wayne State University's College of Lifelong Learning in Southfield.

The center is at 27800 Franklin Road. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays.

Final registration will take place 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Sept. 1-3.

A high school diploma or a GED certificate is all that is needed to enroll, college officials said.

Beginning Sept. 8, two new lab science courses are scheduled for the undergraduate program in the College of Liberal Arts. They are an introduction to microbiology and a course in general chemistry.

Other new courses in the College of Liberal Arts include elementary French and "Primate Behavior."

# Skillman awards grant to Common Ground

The Skillman Foundation of Detroit has awarded a \$20,000 grant to Common Ground, a Birmingham-based human services agency.

Under the terms of the grant, the funds will be used for general operating expenses associated with the delivery of their programs geared to prevention and early intervention in mental health problems.

During 1980, Common Ground provided direct service to 27,000 individuals in Oakland and its surrounding counties. The agency offers free crisis intervention by telephone and in person. Other services include an evening medical clinic, a weekly legal clinic and access to a comprehensive information and referral network.

COMMON GROUND also sponsors a variety of alternative activities to foster health attitudes and behaviors. Presentations on topics such as substance abuse, teenage alcoholism, parent-child relationships, suicide and values clarification are given regularly to schools and local groups.

A theater program offers mime and musical performances which promote good living habits. Other alternative programs include a Sunday evening coffeehouse and free yoga classes.

The agency's services are delivered by more than 300 trained volunteers, including doctors, nurses, lab technicians, lawyers, crisis counselors and business people.

A SUPPORTER of Common Ground since 1973, the Skillman Foundation

directs grants mainly to social service agencies involved primarily with child welfare and youth assistance; educational institutions of college and higher level; and health-care facilities and institutions.
