# Netter goes far in national tourney

Chris and Wendy Gilles, the tennis playing sisters from Plymouth, enjoyed more success last week in the U.S. Junior Girls 14 National Clay Court Championships in Greensboro, N.C. than they did in the 128-player singles draw.

In doubles, Gilles and Davidson, seeded fifth, reached the final with a three-set victory over No. 6 seeds Maryanna Wredell and Debbie Spence, both of California. Gilles and Davidson upset No. 2 seeds Jennifer Fuchs of New York and Nicol Stafford of Florida 2-6, 6-3, 6-4 avenging a loss in the U.S. Junior Girls 14 Indoor Nationals last November at the Franklin Racquet Club in Southfield.

Wendy, who has another year left in the Girls 14s, won her first two rounds before losing in the round of 32 to Indianapolis' Shawn Feltz 6-1, 6-3.

The 13-year-old Plymouth netter then fought through the consolation draw with victories over Pat Van Bylevelt (Miami, Fla.) 6-1, 6-2; Cynthia Bibb (Wichita Falls, Tex.) 6-3, 7-5; Lynda Tate (Irving, Tex.) 7-5, 6-2; and No. 6 seed Spence of Corvallis, Calif., 2-6, 6-4, 6-3. She was eliminated by Eileen Tait of Aberdeen, N.J., 6-1, 6-3.

Chris, 14, won the Sportsmanship Award and finished in the top 25 despite a sore arm. She lost a grueling three-hour match to No. 9 seed Tate 6-4, 4-6, 6-1. Forced to serve underhanded, Gilles then proceeded to beat Stacy Schesslin (Charlotte, N.C.) 6-1, 6-0; Allissa Finerman (Searsdale, N.Y.) 6-1, 6-2; Portia George (Columbia, N.C.) 6-0, 6-2; and Betsy Sommerville (Honolulu, Hawaii) 0-6, 7-5, 6-1. Grace Kim, the No. 5 seed, ousted Gilles from the tourney 6-3, 6-1.

## Skaters to roll for charity drive

So far, sponsors Hughes and Hatcher and Jordache Jeans have invested close to \$25,000 to stage the event. "Everyone who skates will be a winner, because they're all joining the

fight against cancer," said Steve Crombie, Roll for Research chairman and an H&H buyer.

"We're asking skaters to get sponsors to pledge (a suggested \$1) per mile. The top 50 fund-raisers will receive a pair of Jordache Jeans. Everyone who skates will get a cer-

tificate of achievement and a T-shirt."

"We hope to raise \$30,000," Crombie added. The person skating in the funniest costume and the family represented by the greatest number of skaters will also be recognized. Skaters will be able to refresh themselves with

free soft drinks, compliments of Dr. Pepper, and an oxygen company is donating popcorn.

Crombie said the Roll for Research was patterned off a similar event that last year met \$35,000 worth of success in Philadelphia. Skaters complete as many laps (six-tenths of a mile) as

possible from 2-5 p.m. So far, a potpourri of people have entered the Roll for Research, including Hughes and Hatcher's chairman of the board, Gerard Donnelly, H&H president Thomas Doker, most H&H officers and a team of WHIO radio's disc jockeys, directors and talent people.
