Dr. Roach has performed widely in Europe and America and is the recipi-

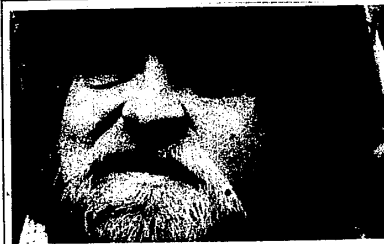
ent of numerous awards. Now residing at southern California, she teaches at California State University and Immaculate Heart College.
