Both of the branches will be presenting educational programs for adults on various topics.

The Farmington Branch will present the following programs:

"For Parents Only: How and Why Kids Use Marijuana," an informational program about drug abuse. A film will be presented along with a discussion and question and answer period. The program will be on Tuesday, Sept. 22, at 7:30.

"Financial Independence: Making Your Dollars Grow" will share new investment information and other financial facts of interest to taxpayers. Interested persons should register for the program by calling 474-7770. The program will be Wednesday, Oct. 21, at 7 p.m.

"Illusions of the Masters: Art with Alice Nichols" will be a four-part presentation on art appreciation. Each lecture will include slides and participants must have registered for the class, at 474-7770. The class meets at 7:30 p.m.

The four series are: "Floral Fantasy," Oct. 22; "The Word of God," Oct. 29; "The Age of Innocence," Nov. 5; and "Women of the Artist," Nov. 12.

"IRS: What's New...Changes in the Law" is a talk about changes in the tax law which may affect income-tax returns this year. There will be a representative of the Internal Revenue Service speaking and answering questions. The program will be Wednesday, Dec. 9, at 7:30 p.m.

There also is a twice-a-month book-discussion group which meets from 10 a.m. to noon. The informal group discusses different fictional and non-fiction books. There are seven more meetings left:
