Cardinal Leo Joseph Suenens, archbishop of Malines, Brussels and primate of Belgium, will speak in Detroit on Sunday, March 15.

Cardinal Suenens was one of the foremost progressives of the II Vatican Council and was among the cardinals considered eligible for the papacy at the death of Pope John XXIII.

His talk, entitled "Co-Responsibility Will Determine the Future of the Church" is one of the Sign Series of special events to be offered by the Archdiocese during 1970.

The lecture, sponsored by the Archdiocese Institute for Continuing Education, will be held in Ford Auditorium, Detroit, at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$2.50 and group rates are available.

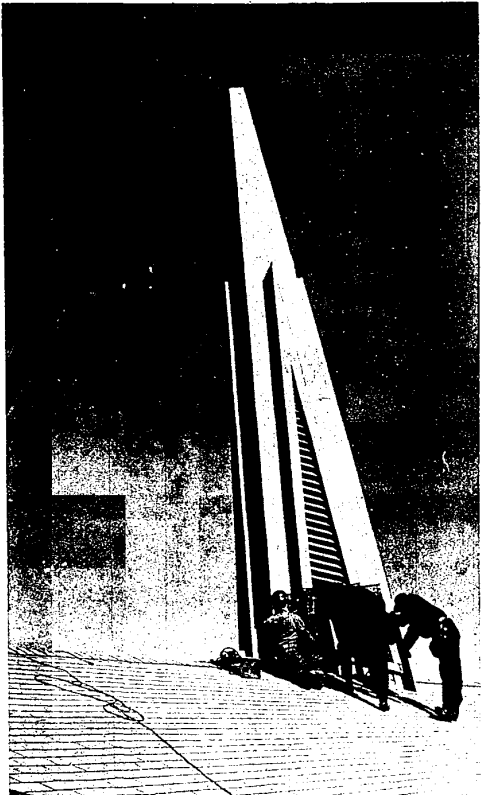
