CROSS COUNTRY SKI OUTING FOR THE HANDICAPPED — Farmington Hills along with the Northwest Therapeutic Recreation Association is sponsoring a day of winter fun at the Coughlan Farm in Troy. All handicapped individuals and their families are invited to join us on Saturday, Jan. 23. Departure time is 11 a.m. from Farmington Hills City Hall. Return will be at about 3:30 p.m. The \$3 fee includes ski equipment, round-trip transportation, entertainment, snowmobiling and a hot dog lunch. Pre-register prior to Wednesday, Jan. 20.

Short courses are offered

This winter Oakland Community College is offering a series of non-credit short courses ranging from Bicycle Rim Weaving, Bagging, and Handwriting Analysis to Self-Hypnosis, Silk Floral Design and Fishing Rod and Lure Making.

The courses will be instructed at the Auburn Hills Campus in Auburn Heights, the Highland Lakes Campus in Union Lake, and the Orchard Ridge Campus in Farmington Hills.

Courses are offered during a variety of time slots. Minimal fees are charged. Senior citizens, however, will be admitted to one short course with a

50-percent tuition discount at the Highland Lakes and Orchard Ridge campuses. Senior citizens interested in enrolling in a short course at the Auburn Hills Campus will be admitted free of charge but are asked to register to reserve a seat.

Students may register for non-credit, short courses up to and including the first class meeting. Approximately 4,000 Camp Fire members will be selling candy Feb. 19-March 8 throughout Wayne, Oakland, Macomb and Livingston counties.

In this area, a group of Bluebirds who call themselves the Rainbow Connection, will be taking telephone orders through their leader Ruth Clary, 624-7059.

The Rainbow Connection will also be setting up shop through the sale days at the Kroger Store on Grand River at Halsted Road.

"Our goal is to sell 2,300 candy bars," Mrs. Clary said, explaining that if the goal is met, the group will win a free weekend at Camp Wathana.

The Detroit Area Council has increased its goal to \$55,000 to be raised from its annual candy sale. The council will once again sell Cadbury Candy Bars. Included are two choices — Cadbury Milk Chocolate with crisped rice and Cadbury Caramello. Both are \$1 per bar.

The sale is the single largest fund-raising effort of the council. The proceeds provide 38 percent of the council's yearly operating budget, and also help maintain Camp Wathana.

The 370-acre resident camp facility is near Holly. Camp Wathana is open 10 months a year for a variety of camping experiences for non-members as well as Camp Fire members.

Camp Fire programs are designed to help today's youth cope with the chal-

lenges, choices and changes of our society. Members have the opportunity to become responsible, self-directed individuals under the guidance of volunteer leadership. Program opportunities range from camping to service projects to help members develop a variety of skills.
