2nd-straight loss for Hawks Undermanned Eagles rip Harrison, 74-47

It looked like trouble from the outset Tuesday night. Redford Thurston was putting his 9-0 record on the line against Farmington Harrison, 8-2 on the season, Thurston had the home-court advantage, but there was a key ingredient missing for the Eagles.

Tim Fredericks, a 6-foot-3 forward and the team's leading scorer and rebounder (22 points and 17 rebounds per game), was out with an injured knee.

Harrison had Steve Hollatz, a strong inside scorer and board man. Without Fredericks, how would Thurston adapt?

Very well, thank you. There was trouble in Thurston's gym Tuesday, but it was all Harrison's, as the Hawks were pounded from start to finish in a 74-47 trouncing.

time the Hawks were in front, Thurston, behind the sharpshooting of senior guard Rich Biskner, rattled off 12 straight points to take a 14-4 advantage. Harrison drew to within eight late in the opening quarter, but never got closer than 10 after that.

Biskner, shooting primarily from the corners, had six points in the first quarter, eight at half and finished with 20, connecting on 10 of 14 floor shots. The Eagles scored the first eight points of the second quarter to take a 24-8 lead and, for all intents and purposes, the game ended then.

"It's the best game he's ever played," Thurston coach Gary Fracklick said of Biskner's performance. "He knew Tim (Fredericks) wouldn't be playing, and we gave him the green light. He loves to shoot.

"I think the key right away was they

(Harrison) stayed in that 1-2-2 zone, and we were hitting from the corner."

AND FROM everywhere else. Fracklick acknowledged that "every one played well." While Biskner did the damage from the guard position, four front-court Eagles combined for 39 points — Mike Stephen, Jim Sibel and Dan Starinsky with 10 each and George Sibel with nine.

Hollatz, surrounded by Thurston players most of the game, still worked and fought his way inside for 23 well-earned points. Gus Keegas was next for Harrison with nine.

Harrison is now 8-3 after consecutive losses. The Hawks lost to Farmington Friday.

Thurston has a tough road game Friday at North Farmington (8 p.m.). Fredericks will return to the lineup for that game.

"THEY WANTED every loose ball — we didn't," was Harrison coach Mike Teachman's reaction after the game. "They played defense — we didn't."

"When we won eight in a row, everyone knew their job, everybody did the little things. Now they're trying to do it the easy way."

"We're going to have to have a little shake-up," the Hawk coach added, assuring that changes would be made in the line-up.

It wasn't just poor play by Harrison that led to the rout. Thurston was nearly infallible, shooting and scoring from everywhere on the court and making few mistakes.

Harrison miscues got the Hawks in trouble early, and they never recovered. Harrison committed nine first-quarter turnovers to just three for Thurston. The Hawks had 19 for the game, Thurston just seven.

CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS
SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
January 18, 1982

Farmington Hills City Council held a Special meeting January 18, 1982. Mayor Burwell opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m. Members present were Burwell, Lange, Wolfe, Dolan, Soronen, Williams and Hughes. Others present were City Manager Savage, Assistant City Manager Costick, City Clerk Cairns, City Attorney Poehlman and Planning Consultant Claude Coates.

Minutes of December 14 and 21, 1981 were approved as submitted, minutes of January 11, 1982 were approved as amended.

City Council approved the resolution for Hatching Sanitary Sewer supplemental Assessment Roll No. C151-B.

City Council tabled consideration of Vacation No. 3-1981 to February 16, 1982. The alley lies between Colgate and Purdue and part of Colgate Avenue in Section 26.

City Council approved Introduction of Zoning Map Amendment No. C82-271 in Section 11, being part of lot 69 of Supervisor's Muer Estates Subdivision No. 1, from RC-2 to OS-1.

City Council approved Introduction of Zoning Map Amendment No. C62-272 in Section 20, northwest corner of Grand River and Drake intersection, from P-1 and RC-2 to B-2 subject to the Attorney's report dated January 25, 1982.

City Council enacted Zoning Map Amendment No. C62-269 in Section 32, south side of Nine Mile Road between Drake Road and Green Hill Commons Subdivision from RA-1 to RP-2.

City Council enacted Zoning Map Amendment No. C62-270 in Section 30, 1.40 acres on southerly line of Farmington Cutoff U.S. Highway 16 from L1-1 to B-3.

City Council enacted amendment No. C82-RR to the Zoning Ordinance Text: Section 1510A, to add a new paragraph No. 11, Municipal Building and Uses. Present paragraph No. 10 to be renumbered 11.

City Council passed a resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the necessary legal instruments regarding reconveyance of certain property from the City to White Motor Company.

City Council approved an executive session for January 25, 1982 re: pending legislation.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned at 9:35 p.m.
