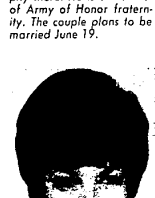
DONNA HOSMAN

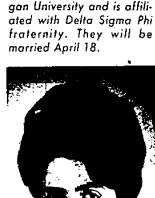
ANGELIA MCCOIN
