## Toronto Male Chorus performs to enrich the Finnish culture

The 33-member Toronto Male Chorus, sometimes known as Mieslaulajat, will be guests of the Finlandia Male Chorus of Detroit and the Finnish Center Association when the group will perform in concert.

The event begins at 7:30 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 27, in the Finnish Cultural Association, 35200 Eight Mile Road, followed by refreshments, a cash bar and dancing with music furnished by the visiting chorus.

Members of the host group expect a large turnout, especially from American Laulajat and retired Finnish Center Association members, to join them in welcoming the Canadian guests.

The Toronto Male Chorus was organized in 1956 to enrich the Finnish culture.

It was in Toronto that the first steps were taken to form a Finnish male chorus union that is now known as the American Laulajat.

Its purpose was to bring together the Finnish male singers of North America for concerts and world tours. The Finnish Male Singers of North America was formally founded in Chicago in 1963, and its central committee headquarters is now located in Thunder Bay, Canada.

The Toronto Male Chorus has won international recognition through the music competitions sponsored by that organization.

Finlandia Male Chorus, which uses Finnish Cultural Center in Farmington Hills for rehearsals and meetings, has an open membership policy. Newcomers are welcomed to sit in on rehearsals at 7:30 p.m. any Tuesday.

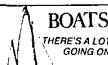
The concert is open to visitors. Admission is \$3 at the door.

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
