

# Adventure School takes next term enrollments

The Adventure School is now taking applications for the 1982-83 school year. The school is a non-profit, non-denominational, independent day school which provides a specialized program for learning disabled students from grades one through 12.

The school is finishing its second year of operation at the former St. Columban School site, 1775 Melton in Birmingham. There is no residency restriction for applicants. Since it is the only school of its kind in the state, students attend from 23 communities in southeastern Michigan.

The Adventure School attempts to establish a safe and rewarding learning environment for its students. The teachers concentrate on developing basic academic skills and building self-esteem and character. The students are involved in the program for varying lengths of time depending on the severity of their deficiencies.

# Project Health-O-Rama offers free health tests

Free health tests will be provided for everyone over age 18 through Project Health-O-Rama.

More than 4,000 volunteers at more than 60 sites throughout seven counties of southeastern Michigan will provide the working hands.

Sponsored by WXYZ-TV, Channel 7; Blue Cross Shield of Michigan and the United Health Organization, a Torch Drive agency, "Project" is in its third year. Last year 30,156 people took advantage of the testing; 6,000 of them had one or more abnormal test results.

This represented health care savings to the community of \$4 million.

Livonia Mall hosts Health-O-Rama for residents in that area Wednesday through Friday, March 31-April 2.

Basic tests at each site will include height- and weight, blood pressure, anemia, vision and the optional blood test will again be provided for a handling fee of \$7.

These chemistries test for kidney disease, liver disease, cholesterol, diabetes, bone disease and gout. Such blood tests usually cost from \$50 to \$80.

Many sites will also offer free special tests for hearing, glaucoma, oral cancer, sickle cell, pap tests, lead poisoning and pulmonary function. All of these tests offer a health care savings of up to \$150 per person.

"THE GOAL of the 1982 project is three-fold," explains William F. Harsen who is executive vice president, United Health Organization and one of the "Project" directors.

"We want to heighten people's awareness of their health in the positive sense of having more and better information about their bodies. Secondly, we look to the testing to point up potential problems before they become more serious - even irreparable.
