This play has the effect of routing the visitors, letting them know they can be run off the field — by the musicians of this area.

This same coach sometimes sees to it that the names and numbers of certain (usually starting) opposition players are screwed up on the program. This means that whenever their star running back carries the ball, the public address man checks the program and announces somebody else's name.

This might seem kind of cheap, but remember some of those kids like to hear their names over that loudspeaker. Having it wrong might make them think less of themselves.

Seems that, come halftime, the visitors' locker room always is locked tight, with no attendant in sight.


