

# Tenebrae Rites Set By Orchard

The Tenebrae Service, an ancient rite of candlelighting, is scheduled in Orchard United Methodist Church, 3050 Farmington Road, Farmington, at 7:30 p.m. Good Friday, March 27.

Twelve men of the church have been selected to represent the 12 disciples. In the service, 12 candles are lighted symbolizing the calling of the disciples, and then each is extinguished to show the disciples' falling away.

The service concludes with the sanctuary in complete darkness. The candles then will be lighted again on Easter Sunday.
