What would happen if a team of astronauts were trapped in space and unable to return to earth?

"Maroned" deals with this question with a blend of science fiction and documentary techniques, and the result is a spellbinding film.

The film tells the story of a space shot and a five-month test period of the astronauts living in space and then the failure of the space capsule's rockets to fire for re-entry.
