He was buried at Holy Se-pulche Cemetery where his brother, SQT Michael Francis (also an OLS graduate) is bur-ied. Michael was killed in combain in September, 1957.

"I could, ve stopped him from going to Vietnam after he had volunteered to go," Francis said, "I had all the forms from the Red Cross and all that was left was signing the papers.

"But Bill blew up when I told him. He had done some crazy things and gotten into trouble, but nothing really bad. He just felt he owed a debt to society and this was his way of paying.

"Bill was a beautiful person.
The one thing that bothers me is that I don't know if he was sure he was doing her right bing after seeing what happened to Mile and watching the progress of the war."
