McGovern helped Groves to a second-place finish behind Lathrup in the MSAA. Groves was one of the few teams to beat Andover this past season.

"Colleen has an especially strong vertical leap," said Groves' coach Myron Campbell. "I mean this girl has the legs. She can really jump."

"Because of this, she's always been an exceptionally fine spiker and blocker. Her spikes go straight down because she gets up so high."

Winkler was Lahser's Iron Lady — always in the lineup despite injuries.

"I would say that her main strengths are her courage and desire," said Lahser coach Fred Youngman. "She played every game all season and was never taken out. Sure, we had injuries — a hyper-extended thumb, for example — but you'd never know it when she was playing."

"Dawn doesn't have the height of a lot of players, she's only 5-foot-7. But she's a powerful left-hand hitter."

LUBIENIECKI was voted top coach after she guided North's Raiders to a 17-5 record and a state Class A district championship in a field which included Lathrup, Andover and Farmington.

North was the longest-lived area volleyball team, finally falling to Bridgeport, 17-15, 15-12, in the regional tournament at Flint Southwestern.

"That was a tremendous match," Lubieniecki said. "It was all hits, blocks and digs... no junk. It was probably the best my kids have ever played, and their (Bridgeport's) coach said about the same about their players."

North had to settle for second place in the rough Northwest Suburban League, but the Raiders did win the Andover and Bloomfield tournaments.

A North Farmington player, senior Michele Lister, was picked for the
