

Seaholm lands 2 representatives

Sirna, a student at Blake Gymnastics Centre in Warren, was ninth all-around at the state meet. Her best individual showing was off the vault, where she finished seventh overall with a score of 8.75.

Faced by her third-place finish, Sirna was sixth all-around at the regional meet. She was third in vault at the SMA league meet with a score of 9.

JILL McBRIDE

Jill McBride is the only senior on the first team.

McBride, the heart of Seaholm's team the past three seasons, had her tonsils removed just prior to the season and did not compete in the Maple's first few meets. Seaholm finished with a 10-3 overall record, but were 8-1 with McBride in the line-up.

"(McBride) made a big difference in our team score when she got back," said Seaholm coach Robin Limauro. "That's when we started scoring in the high 120s."

McBride was third all-around at the state meet with a total score of 35.1. She finished behind three-time winner Jodi Thompson of East Kentwood (36.5) and Sharon McNete of Royal Oak Kimball (36).

McBride won the balance beam competition with an 8.8 and finished third on bars (9.05), 11th off the vault (8.65) and 12th in floor exercises (8.6). At the regional, McBride was third in both bars and beam.

As a team, Seaholm finished second at East Kentwood at the state meet and second to Troy at the regional meet. Seaholm was also runner-up to Troy in the annual Southeastern Michigan Association (SMA) meet.

JENNY MATZ

Junior Jenny Matz tied for fifth all-around at the state meet with East Kentwood's Kim Fagley. Each posted an overall score of 34.05.

Matz's best showings were in vault and beam, where she finished fifth and

sixth places respectively. She was also among the top 12 in floor exercises.

At the regional meet, Matz was second on beam and fourth in both the bars and floor exercises. She also tied teammate McBride for fifth place off the vault.

"Because Jill was out for the first four meets, I would have to say Jenny was our most consistent performer this year," said her coach, Robin Limauro.

In the Southeastern Michigan Association (SMA) meet, Matz was third on beam, fourth in vaulting and tied for fifth in floor exercises.

JOSEPHINE SMITH

Junior Josephine Smith was the pillar of Farmington's team.

Smith, also an established swimmer, was 19th at the state meet in floor exercises with a score of 8.45. At the regional meet, she was second in floor exercises with an 8.7.

"She (Smith) was pretty strong for us all year," said her coach, Marta Scharrenberg. "She was a lot more consistent for us this year. She picked up a lot more confidence."

"She's gotten herself back into gymnastics after a little layoff, and I think

she did extremely well this year considering the tough competition," she said.

Smith's best overall effort this year was at the Northwest Suburban League meet where she finished first all-around with a score of 34.40. Smith won every event except the balance beam.

COACHES OF THE YEAR

Sandy Smith of Troy and Mary Johnesee of North Farmington — two coaches who harvest perennially strong teams — were selected as co-coaches of the year.

Smith led Troy to its second consecutive Southeastern Michigan Association (SMA) championship and a first-place showing at the regional meet. The Colts were 10-1 overall this year and are 22-1 over the past two seasons.

"We did a lot more than I ever expected with such a young team," said Smith, who has been Troy coach for the

past seven years. "I can't believe how much we improved. We should have a good team again next year."

North Farmington handed Troy its only loss of the year, 126.05-125.65. The Raiders finished with an 11-1 overall record, with their lone defeat coming from Birmingham Seaholm.

The Raiders also won the Northwest Suburban League (NSL) championship for the fourth straight season.

North Farmington was third at the regional meet and won the Dearborn Invitational.
