The five Mountain Jacks restaurants, located in Troy, Farmington Hills, Warren, Ann Arbor, and Dearborn Heights, last fall introduced a new specialty menu. Since that time customer comments have

ranged from "outstanding" to "truly unique," according to local managers. Two of the locations, Warren and Dearborn Heights, were formerly known as Stag & Hound. While ownership and management remain the same, the names of the restaurants have been changed to provide continuity and eliminate any confusion caused by restaurants of different names serving identical menus.
