

Variety offered at Mercy College

Two-, five- and 11-week courses will be offered at Mercy College of Detroit this summer. Registration for summer courses is going on now for classes beginning in May and June.

Mini- (two-week) courses include "Leadership," "Technology and Religion," "Alienation and Occupations," "How to Analyze and Present Ideas," "The Journal: A Tool for Creativity," and others.

New five-week courses being offered this summer include "Studies in Film: Great Performances" and "Musical Comedy." "Studies in Crisis Behavior" and "Social Problems" are two additions to the 11-week schedule of classes.

In addition to day and evening courses, Saturday classes will also meet this summer. Mercy's Weekend College is the only one in Michigan offering degree programs in specific areas of study, instead of in general studies. Programs offered are: business admin-

istration, health services, public administration, legal assistant and medical record science. Summer courses will be offered in each of these areas, as well as in English and psychology.

Mini-course sessions begin May 3, May 10 and June 21. Five- and 11-week courses begin on May 17; a second session of five-week courses begins on June 28. Weekend College sessions begin on May 15.
