HEALTHY Jones restaurant in Southfield offers one of the more interesting brunches around from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. each Sunday.

The all-you-can-eat menu (\$7.95 for adults, \$2.95 for children 12 and under) includes such healthy-sound-

ing stuff as fresh fruits, salad with vegetable tray, vegetable casserole, honey-baked chicken, whole-wheat bagels and the restaurant's carrot cake.

Other dishes on the menu are potato pancakes with sour cream and homemade apple sauce, creamed herring, smoked salmon and cream cheese ball, and cheese tray.

An all-you-can-eat daily dinner special features fried or baked chicken, baked potato and steamed carrots and zucchini for \$3.95.

Healthy Jones is at 29221 Northwestern Highway.

SPRING is being celebrated with a menu of seasonal dishes changed daily (in addition to the regular menu) at the Meating Place in Orchard Lake.

Along with the special entrees is a

complimentary glass of California wine. Each evening six to eight entrees are highlighted, such as Michigan Rainbow Trout with Olive Butter Sauce and a glass of Concannon Chateau Blanc 1980, or Paupiette of Sole with Lobster Mousse, Beurre Blanc Sauce and Lobster Sauce with Delicate Chateaufort 1978.

TABLESIDE service is the grand addition at Mactus Sly Fox in Birmingham. Some of these offerings are just for two, such as a main course of Chateaubriand for Two

(\$32.90), or a dessert selection of Pears Flambe for Two (\$8.50).

More tableside dishes are pepper steak (\$17.25) and duck Hawaiian (\$14.95). Chef Larry Nygard also is presenting new specialties including Breast of Chicken a la Grecque, Filet of Salmon en Croûte Duxelle and Medallions of Beef Princecess.

Smoked Rainbow Trout and Seafood Crepe Bengal have joined the list of appetizers.

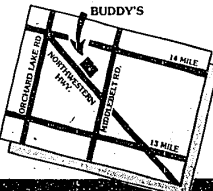
