

3 from Farmington in BBAA competition

Three artists from Farmington Hills have their work now on display in Birmingham Bloomfield Art Association's (BBAA) Michigan Fine Arts Competition.

Edee Joplich, Linda Centivany and Avedis Khandjian submitted works that were chosen by juror Grace Hartigan for the prestigious show.

"We are winners just by having our work chosen to be shown," Joplich said. "The odds were pretty staggering."

Less than 100 pieces were picked from the 1,200 submitted.

The number of entries that poured into the BBAA is believed to be in response to a void that developed when the Detroit Institute of Arts abandoned its exhibit for Michigan artists.

It is the first exhibit of its kind staged by the BBAA, which was jammed with viewers on opening day. The Michigan show remains at BBAA through April 24, at 1516 South Cranbrook, Birmingham.
