The 14-game spring season starts the first weekend in May and ends in July, and the 10-game summer season begins in July and ends in October. The spring-season entry fee is \$275; the shortened summer season fee will be

THERE ARE currently more than 400 teams registered for the spring season. Dieters said there were only 221 teams last year.

Leagues will be in progress from 6-11-30 p.m. Monday through Friday; Saturday and Sunday leagues are available. Dieters said there are approxi-

"Last year, we had 500 teams for both sessions. This year, we could have up to 1,000," said Dieters, who hopes to construct a nine-hole golf course on the facility soon.

"We couldn't survive with just teams for the Rochester-Troy areas. We have to draw from different areas like Roseville, St. Clair Shores, Southfield, Bir-

mingham and Farmington

"We figure that within 10 minutes of our place is where half of our teams will come from. What happens is that the teams which get real good in their local leagues want more competition so they come out here to play.

"I believe our big advantage is that we don't have any residency requirements. And people like to come out here for the country atmosphere.

"Plus, this year, we've computerized our scheduling, and it's now possible for a team to play in two leagues on the same night, and they can play back-to-back games so that they don't have to wait around. We can accommodate almost anything now."

"By the end of last year our fields we're getting beat up, and we knew we had to solve some grading problems," he said. "But this year we have a lot of improvements, including two more concession stands and a weekly newspaper (called Extra Innings) that will contain league standings."
