SENIOR ADULT GOLF LEAGUE — The men's senior adult golf league will begin the 1992 season on Friday, May 7. The league meets at the San Marino Municipal Golf Course and tee times begin at 8 a.m. We are looking for interested individuals who would like to join the league. CAMP RAINBOW — Camp Rainbow is a summer day camp for all mentally and physically impaired individuals. The program operates Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. and offers a wide variety of recreation activities. Daily activities will incorporate socialization skills, gross and fine motor coordination and self awareness. Additional activities will include swimming, field trips and overnight camping during specific sessions. The first session will begin July 6 and take place at Oakland Community College, Orchard Ridge Campus. The camper registration fee is \$30 per session. Register now, space is limited.

SPRING SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT — The fifth annual "Spring Training Tournament" is slated for April 30, May 1 and 2 at the Knights of
