There are 40 Broadway companies, with 800- to 1,000-seat theaters, and 350 off-Broadway and off-off-Broadway companies with smaller, more intimate theaters. Both Broadway and off-off-Broadway performances are produced under union contract, and last as long as the public will pay for tickets.
At off-off-Broadway theaters, the union permits "showcase performances" to be produced at non-union wages if the show has a limited run, usually 4-5 weeks.
