

Fourth seat open on OCC board

The on-again, off-again resignation of Oakland Community College Trustee Richard J. Pappas is on again.

It means voters will have a fourth seat to fill in the June election.

Pappas submitted his resignation to the OCC board Thursday, and the board formally accepted it. "I've accepted the post of dean of community services at Jackson Community College," Pappas said Thursday night.

College officials hurried to inform 20 persons who had taken out petitions that the four remaining years of Pappas's term were available in addition to two years of Gordon Henderson's term and the full six-year posts now held by incumbents Earl Anderson and Suzanne Reynolds.

PAPPAS, OF Troy, had been a business instructor at Jackson CC before

moving to Oakland County several years ago to enter business. In 1980 he was elected to a six-year term on the OCC board.

Two months ago, he orally announced his resignation in order to accept an administrative post at a community college system in Des Moines, Iowa. The board let the college district know it would fill his post by appointment and asked interested persons to submit letters and resumes. Fourteen persons responded.

But on the March night when trustees were scheduled to screen the applications, Pappas announced he had changed his mind about the Des Moines job. Since his resignation from the OCC board wasn't in writing and hadn't been formally accepted, he was still a trustee.

This time he put it in writing, and the board accepted it by voice vote.

SO FAR, none of the 20 persons with

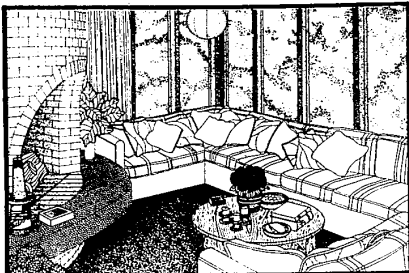
petition forms has filed. Deadline is 4 p.m. Tuesday.

Board chairman Anderson announced he would be a candidate for a fourth term. The retired Madison Heights union official and labor consultant has been on the OCC board since 1964, when it opened for business.

Petitions must contain at least 50 and not more than 200 signatures of college district residents in order to qualify a candidate for the ballot, according to state law. There is no primary.

President Robert F. Roelofs warned persons who already have filled in the length of term for which they're running may not alter the petition to say "4" if they choose to seek the remainder of Pappas's term. They would have to get fresh forms and start over.
