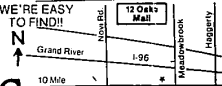

Mums give late summer beauty

About the middle of August until the last freeze the first part of October, gardeners are always wishing that they had more chrysanthemums in their gardens.

We have a very talented group of "mum" enthusiasts in the greater Detroit area and they are having a sale of rooted cuttings through their membership. Call Mrs. Newton 422-6155 for information on securing these choice seedlings. The plant society will host the National Chrysanthemum Show at the Tel-Twelve Mall in Southfield in October.

Chrysanthemums can be a real joy to care for in your garden. This is the time to discard a plant you do not like. It is so easy to propagate the good ones. If you plant three or five plants in a grouping you will have a good strong color accent.

Here is an easy way to have many plants from a favorite. Dig up the total plant, preferably with a fork. Raise the plant mass to chest level and let the plant drop to the group. Chances are it will break into many pieces with roots. Sprinkle the "fallen mess" and cover with an old rug or the like, to prevent the pieces from drying out.

Prepare an area where you wish to replant the seedlings. Those you wish to

share, place in a plastic bag for friends or donate to a plant sale. Before the rooted seedling are replanted pinch out the top to encourage branching.

TO ASSURE a well-shaped plant with many flowers you will have to pinch out each growing branch tip about every three weeks until August first, then let the plants bud up for the future flowering.

If you have a plant which gives large single flowers, you will pinch off side shoots and encourage the growth of just one large, perfect flowering. If you go overboard as a chrysanthemum specialist you will be interested in training a plant on wires so that the growth can resemble a waterfall, the Japanese way. Those who have been to China report spectacular training of mums on wire by the Chinese.

garden, do consider the "bush champion cucumber" (Burpee) which will not have tangling vines and can be planted 12 or 15 inches apart. Four hills will give a family plenty of cucumbers for salads, plus some for canning. It is the crispness which denotes a good cucumber.

Butterbush squash is another compact vegetable you will want to investigate. It doesn't develop on a vine and the plants can be planted about 18 inches apart. Each compact plant should give you four or five squash.

As you make plans for your vegetable garden look up the new varieties. The goal of the well-known hybridizers has been to come up with compact growth characteristics. Even a patio garden could brag about its harvest, leaving the flowers to hanging baskets.

If you have six square feet to devote to watermelons, they also have joined the "compact-style" of gardening.
