### X marks spot for X-way photo

Yellow Xs painted inside black, 8-foot circles are appearing on long stretches of 1-94, US-23 and 1-75 free ways in southern Michigan. They are markers for aerial surveys by the Michigan Department of Transportation of the Section of Section

AERIAL PHOTOS taken along I-75 and US-23 will be mainly for surveys to help determine the priority for repairs to pavement joints and resurfacing. The survey along 1-94 will be in prep-aration for upgrading much of the free-

way, including possible interchange re-construction and recycling or resurfac-ing of the roadways.

"Many sections of our oldest free-ways are 20 to 25 years old and even older," said Gerald J. McCarthy, MDO's deputy director for highways. "They require resionation, resurfacing aid, in the some cases, reconstruction."

"THE WORK will be done as federal and state funds are available," he said. "Our major emphasis now is on main-tenance and operation of the existing system rather than on construction on the whighway." McCarthy said Congress increased federal aid funding this year for repairs and construction on the interstate freeway system. Michigan will receive 425.8 million for the program in the current fiscal year, with federal money paying 30 percent of the project cost.
